

## IWFH – COVID 19 UPDATED GUIDELINES (REV 11-12-20)

**PLEASE NOTE THAT ANY PARTICIPANT OR SPECTATOR THAT IS NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH ANY OF THE POLICIES BELOW WILL BE REQUIRED TO LEAVE THE FACILITY AND TEAMS MAY BE SUBSEQUENTLY FORFEITED FROM THE REMAINDER OF THE TOURNAMENT.**

-IWFH Staff: IWFH staff goes through a mandatory COVID-19 prescreening prior to each of their shifts. They are required to wear masks and gloves at all times.

-Player/Spectator Screening: We ask that all those entering our facilities do their own screening at home and anyone showing signs or symptoms of COVID-19 must not enter the IWFH facility. For detailed guidance on home screening, go to [www.cdc.gov/screening](http://www.cdc.gov/screening).

-Masks: ALL who enter all game facilities MUST wear a mask. If you do not have one, you will not be allowed in. This includes all players, coaches, referees, and spectators. Coaches and Spectators must wear masks AT ALL TIMES. Players and referees may remove their masks ONLY when they are on the court and must wear masks on the bench and at all other times.

-Spectators - According to the most recent proclamation, an athlete may have up to two spectators attend. **IMPORTANT: For definition purposes, The 1-2 spectators per athlete will constitute a “group”.** Our policy for this upcoming weekend will be that the 1-2 spectators/group must walk in with the athlete and at that point the athlete and the spectator(s) will receive a hand stamp. Coaches are not allowed extra spectators, but will NOT be included in the total group count. However, if the total number of spectators per group exceeds two, the coach must then stand six feet away from his group, before games and when exiting the facility. **NO SPECTATORS WILL BE ALLOWED ENTRY WITHOUT THEIR ATHLETE.**

-Spectator Seating - At the IWFH, spectator seating will be clearly marked and will consist of bar stools, bleacher seating, and folding chairs. “There must be six feet of social distancing between each “group”. Please Note:

- Barstools will be marked in sets of two for each “group”. Each group will be separated by two closed barstools.
- Bleacher seating will be marked for groups of two, with 6 feet distance between groups, including the middle bench.
- We will have sets of two folding chairs on the courts without barstools spaced six feet apart on the baseline. This will take place on courts 6, 7, and 8. **SPECTATORS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO MOVE CHAIRS.**

### **Transition between Games**

- 1) While waiting for your game, athletes and their two spectators must stay on the perimeter of the facility, maintaining six feet of distance, and must not enter the playing area until the game before theirs is finished and all participants have left the court.
- 2) Teams will be given a minimum of two minutes to warm up. Halftimes will be two minutes long. Players and coaches must wear masks at halftime.
- 3) At the conclusion of your game, players, coaches and spectators promptly vacate the court and exit the facility. Post game huddles, pictures, etc. are not allowed anywhere in the IWFH.

-Sanitation Procedures: High touch point areas will be sanitized after every game.

-Water Fountains: The water fountains and filling stations will be turned off. Please make sure that your athlete brings their own water bottle.

-Basketballs: One Coach per team will be allowed to bring three basketballs in a secured net or bag. Basketballs may be used from the start of warm-ups until the start of the game and then throughout half time. Absolutely no other basketballs will be allowed in the facility and violators will be required to take their ball back to their car. Home team will provide the game ball, and we will have sanitization materials available for coaches to sanitize the game ball before and after the game.
